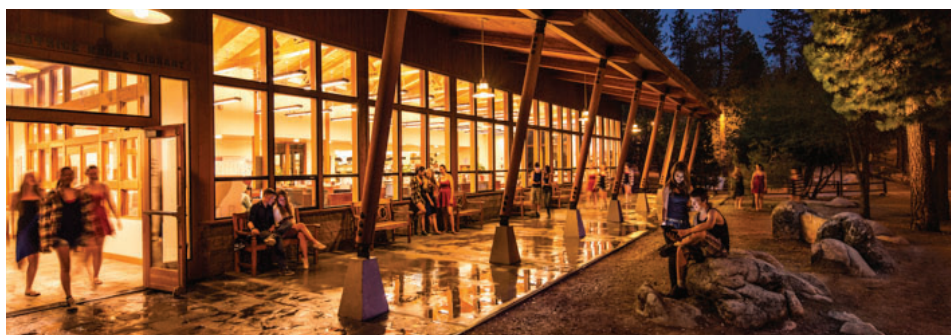

Academics

Idyllwild Arts Academy provides pre-professional training in the arts and a comprehensive college preparatory curriculum to a diverse student body of gifted young artists from all over the world. Arts Majors

Students can choose to study in one of the following art disciplines: Classical Music, Jazz, Songwriting, Visual Arts, Acting, Musical Theatre, Design & Production, Dance, Film & Digital Media, Fashion Design, Interdisciplinary Arts, and Creative Writing.

Advanced Placement (AP) Courses

Although AP courses aren't offered, students can enroll in weighted honors courses and have the opportunity to take AP exams.

ESL Program

The ESL program immerses international students in an all-English classroom environment with Beginning, Intermediate, or Advanced courses with small class sizes.

Success Rate

100% of students are accepted to a 4 year college or university.

Campus Life

Located in the San Jacinto Mountains, the campus comprises state-of-the-art classrooms, spacious and comfortable dormitories, large dining hall, and an architecturally stunning library. In addition, there are sound-proofed private rehearsal studios, sound stage, performance theatre, recital hall, outdoor amphitheater, Health Center, and student store set amongst scenic walking trails and roads. There are five dormitories on campus, and students reside in double occupancy rooms.

Activities

Activities are organized for every weekend, including off campus outings, student performances on campus, and visits to Los Angeles and Disneyland, among others.
