ESL Program

Dean College offers the International Student FOCUS Program in which students receive English language support in credit-bearing courses that combine cultural orientation, language instruction and optional individualized tutoring to provide a holistic educational experience.

Degrees Offered

Dean College offers the Associate of Arts (AA) and Associate of Science (AS) degrees, as well as the Bachelor of Arts (BA) and Bachelor of Science (BS) degrees.

Student Success

95% of Bachelor degree graduates completed their program in 4 years or less and 96% were employed or admitted to graduate programs within 1 year of graduation. 98% of Associate degree graduates were accepted to some of the top 4-year Colleges or Universities in the US. 100% of Bachelor degree students participate in at least one internship before graduation.

Special Features

The focus of a Dean College education, referred to as the "Dean Difference," is the unique commitment to every student, combining academics and support networks to help students achieve their personal and academic goals with real-world learning, marketable career skills, and core knowledge. This is shown in the incredible success of students after graduation, and in the stellar transfer matriculations of the Associate degree

students; 78% of students are pursuing a Bachelor's degree while 22% pursue an Associate's degree.

Dean College has been named one of the Best Colleges North 2019 and College of Distinction. Dean College's town of Franklin is named after Benjamin Franklin, and is home to the first public library in America.

Academic Services

The Morton Family Learning Center provides academic support to fit individual students' learning needs, with faculty, and peer tutoring available, as well as the Berenson Writing and Math Centers. Academic Advisors meet regularly with all students to provide academic counseling, course planning, and overall support. The Arch Learning Community also offers a fee-based program for students with diagnosed learning differences.
