Arts. Maine Central Institute is also home
to the Bossov Ballet Theatre, which is
both a performing company, as well as
an international pre-professional ballet
school and offers the unique opportunity
for students to study classical ballet as
part of the academic curriculum.

Campus Life


The campus was established in 1866
and has historic buildings dating back
to 1869. The beautiful campus features
a state-of-the-art Math and Science
Center, library, music building, two
gymnasiums, four residence halls, ballet
studio and the MCI Trustee Memorial
Student Center, which houses the dining
hall, performance stage, food court, and
game room. Boarding students reside
in single-sex residences on campus,
supervised by resident faculty and staff.
Each residence has its own recreation
and laundry rooms.

Activities

Athletics and activities play an important
educational role at Maine Central
Institute. Students are required to either
participate in one full season of a sport,
or to be active in at least one other club
or activity. Leadership opportunities are
also available in Student Council, Dorm
Council, and in the numerous clubs on
campus.
