Millikin University maintains dual-degree programs with the University of Missouri - Kansas City (UMKC) and Washington University in St. Louis for its 3+2 Pre-Engineering and Computer Science programs. These are offered in Biomedical Engineering, Chemical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Computer Engineering, Computer Science, Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, System Science Engineering, and Pre-Medical Technology. Millikin's "Performance-Learning" approach has students demonstrate their learning by working with real companies, and on real projects to better prepare graduates for life after college.
