TRANSFER TO: Seattle University

Our new exclusive program welcomes students to apply as transfer applicants to the nationally ranked Seattle University! With an exciting location in the heart of downtown Seattle, and ranked #127 in the nation by US News and World Report, this is an opportunity not to be missed!

Each year, Seattle University welcomes transfer applicants from around the world and provides a simple application pathway especially for those studying in Washington state!

- Students may be eligible to transfer to Seattle University with 90 completed quarter credits and junior standing if they:
 - have completed their DTA Associate's degree at a community college in the state of Washington!
 - have completed their Associate's degree within the IGETC curriculum from a community college in the state of California!
- Students from all academic backgrounds with college credits are welcome to apply, and we work one-on-one with students to walk through the admissions process and confirm transfer credit eligibility.
- Students who transfer with at least 45 quarter credits, a cumulative GPA of 3.0 and a B or higher in English Composition I may have the TOEFL requirement waived.

(* Associate degree coursework must include any specific prerequisite courses for the desired major.)

This opportunity welcomes students to complete their Bachelor's degree at Seattle University in a wide range of majors! Both domestic and international students are also eligible for special academic merit scholarships from Seattle University that can range from \$5,000 - \$15,000 annually!
