Academics

From Years 7 through Sixth Form, Harrogate Ladies' College focuses on providing a solid foundation for knowledge and the skills for girls to work independently, develop valuable research and analysis skills, and explore subjects that truly inspire them!

GCSE

Academic studies are more focused in Years 10 and 11 as students are preparing for the GCSEs. In line with the national curriculum, all students undertake GCSE's in Maths, English Language, English Literature, and Science, and then select additional subjects (including foreign language) to explore.

A-Levels (Sixth Form)

Harrogate Ladies' College offers a wide and diverse range of subjects at A Level, all taught in small groups. Students will choose three or four subjects to study for this 2-year program. Additional qualifications are also offered to excite and inspire students, including the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ).

EAL Program

Within the English as an Additional Language program, the college works to tailor their English support for each student's individual needs.

Success Rate

On average, over 90% of students are accepted to University and more than 75% of students receive offers from Russell Group Universities

Campus Life

The campus is just a 5-minute walk from the town center in Harrogate, and the facilities include: science and language labs, art and photography studios, chapel, libraries, Theatre, 350-seat Assembly Hall, Music House with practice rooms, and extensive sports facilities including a 25-meter swimming pool, tennis and netball courts, and Sports Hall. There are 3 boarding houses on campus, as well as the dedicated Sixth Form boarding house.

There are more than 50 clubs and societies, as well as performing and creative arts programs to join! The weekend program also offers a range of cultural, athletic and social activities.
