Academics

Darlington's curriculum is committed to the whole student, prioritizing the strength of each individual while preparing them for college. They offer a wide range of visual and performing arts, as well as AP and Honors courses, and an Advisory Program to provide in-depth support. Students will also participate in iPeriods, a chance to take intellectual risks and explore new topics, without the pressure of grades. The Glenn Teaching & Learning Center provides specialist support for students with learning differences.

Campus Life

The expansive Darlington campus surrounds a small lake with bell tower, and is home to the Lower and Upper School academic buildings, Zelle Fine Arts Center, Kawamura Science Center, and the McCallie-Kennedy Student Center. The sports complex includes the Memorial Athletic Stadium, various fields for softball, baseball, soccer, and lacrosse, and tennis courts. Students reside in 6 English-style Boarding Houses on campus (3 male & 3 female) in mostly double rooms, with dedicated live-in Dorm Parents.

Activities

Students are always busy with after-school activities and clubs, athletics, community service opportunities, and fun weekend excursions! International students can try out for Junior Varsity (JV) athletics in their first year, and then Varsity in their second year. Other club sports including Running and Disc Golf.

Sports
