Academics

Rabun Gap's Applied Learning curriculum offers a seamless blend of rigorous academics and real world applications, with a focus on equipping students with 5 essential skills: collaboration, creativity, critical thinking, character, and cultural competency. The Academic Resource Center offers one-on-one support and tutoring. They also have a strong focus on performing and visual arts, with a nationally recognized Cirque (Circus Arts) Program!

Campus Life

Rabun Gap's 1,400 acre campus includes hiking trails, a private lake, and an extensive Athletics complex, with lighted stadium, tennis courts, various fields, 3 gymnasiums, indoor pool, fitness center, and golf greens. The Academic halls and Modern Arts & Technology Building are all central to campus, and home to a 600-seat Theatre, music practice rooms, art gallery, art & dance studios, and film/design lab. Students reside in 7 Dorms (one for Junior Boarding) with live-in Dorm Parents, and enjoy the new Dining Hall, as well as the dedicated Student Center with game room, kitchen and snack bar!

Activities

Students are required to participate in the Afternoon Program, with clubs, athletics, Outdoor Program, STEAM, Intramural sports, Environmental Stewardship, Yearbook and many others! Weekends are also filled with fun local activities and trips to nearby Atlanta and Asheville!
