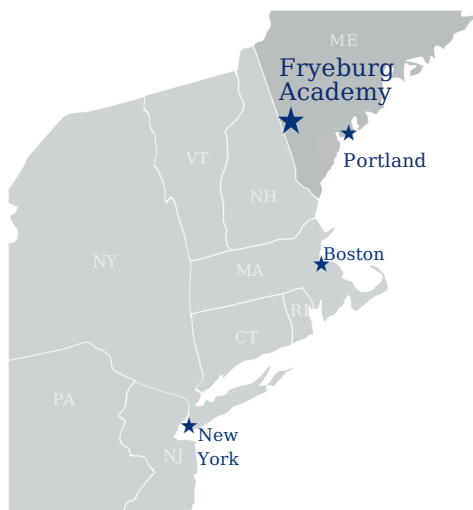

Academics

The curriculum at Fryeburg is designed to prepare students for limitless opportunities, providing more than 150 courses, including AP, Honors, College Prep, and technical prep courses. By challenging students to think critically and communicate effectively, Fryeburg is preparing students to be the next generation of leaders. There are also over 30 creative and technical arts courses offered! One of Fryeburg's distinct programs is May Term, when students spend 3 weeks focusing on special projects to explore new passions!

Advanced Placement Courses

15 available including: English Language & Composition, English Literature & Composition, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Statistics, Chemistry, Biology, Physics C: Mechanics, Computer Science A, Computer Science Principles, Environmental Science, US History, European History, French Language, and Music Theory.

ESL Program

The Center for International Students (CIS) provides a range of ESOL courses, including three levels of English, College Writing, and foundations Science and Biology courses. In addition to the English language program, they offer Orientation and transition support, as well as TOEFL and SAT preparation.

Success Rate

100% of students are accepted to a 4 year college or university.

Campus Life

The classic New England style campus is home to multiple academic buildings, The Eastman Performing Arts Center with 400 seat theatre and 2 art galleries, Media & Film Studio, Fitness Center, Wellness Center, 5 athletic fields, outdoor and indoor tracks, a challenge course and climbing wall, Student Center and Dining Hall, and four dormitories. Students live in mostly double rooms, and each residence has a large common area, laundry facilities, and live-in faculty Dorm Parents.

Activities

All students participate in afternoon activities: including clubs, sports, and other fun events that change weekly. From cooking to arts, and swimming to ping-pong, there are options to fit every student interest. Weekends are filled with a variety of fun excursions and outdoor recreation with many local and cultural activities for students to choose from, including visits to Boston and Portland!

Sports

Teams include: Alpine Ski Team, Baseball (boys), Basketball, Cross Country, Field Hockey (girls), Football (boys), Golf, Ice Hockey (boys), Indoor Track, Lacrosse, Mountain Biking, Nordic Ski Team, Soccer, Softball (girls), Tennis, Track & Field, Ultimate Frisbee, and Wrestling.
