Academics

Lincoln Academy offers a wide range of more than 135 courses, with Honors and Advanced Placement options. They have an extensive STEM center, offering 42 courses in the STEM and science fields. Lincoln Academy is also known for their Arts programs with more than 30 courses in the performing and visual arts, including music, theater, acting, film production, and many 2D & 3D arts, like drawing, painting, sculpture, jewelry and graphic design!

Advanced Placement Courses

18 available including: English Language & Composition, English Literature & Composition, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Statistics, Biology, Chemistry, Physics 1, Environmental Science, Computer Science A, Computer Science Principles, US History, European History, Macroeconomics, French Language, Spanish Language, 2D Art & Design, and Music Theory.

ESL Program

Lincoln Academy requires students to have an intermediate level of English and provides a supportive environment for full English integration. They plan to add ESOL classes to the curriculum to more fully support language acquisition.

99% of Boarding students are accepted to a college or university.

Campus Life

The modern campus is made up of five academic buildings with state-of-the-art science facilities and STEM Center, spacious Dining Commons with patio, Theater, and Health Center with full-time Nurse. There are multiple athletic facilities, including gymnasium, turf fields, tennis courts, and new baseball and softball fields. The modern dormitory is home to about 50 boarding students with separate male and female wings, and 5 Residential Dorm Parent families.

Activities

Clubs meet three times per week in a Focused Learning Block during the day. All students are encouraged to follow their passions and can choose from more than 40 different clubs, some of which change every trimester! They cover many interests, including Model UN, Debate Team, Student Council, Robotics Club and others! They offer many fun weekend activities, with trips to Portland and Boston, skiing, game nights, hiking, kayaking, sporting events, and more!

Athletic Teams include: Baseball (boys), Basketball, Cheerleading, Cross Country, Field Hockey (girls), Golf, Indoor Track, Lacrosse, Soccer, Softball (girls), Swimming, Tennis, Track & Field, and Wrestling.
