Academics

Marianapolis provides a rigorous college preparatory curriculum while nurturing students to become responsible and independent learners. Beyond the classroom, the LEAP program provides experiential education with opportunities for students to engage in hands-on learning locally, and across the US and the world. With a variety of programs in the arts, students can master their craft, whether in The Blackbox Theatre, dance studio, or in the visual arts classrooms.

Advanced Placement Courses

20 available including: English Language & Composition, English Literature & Composition, Precalculus, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Statistics, Chemistry, Biology, Physics 1, Computer Science A, Computer Science Principles, US History, World History, Psychology, Macroeconomics, Microeconomics, European History, African American Studies, Spanish Language, and Spanish Literature.

ESL Program

The ESL department offers three Core courses for students to strengthen their skills in four main areas: speaking, listening, writing and reading, with the goal of being well prepared for University. These courses are supported by the LEAP Experiential Learning Program, where students receive hands-on experience with a variety of activities while building cultural competence.

Campus Life

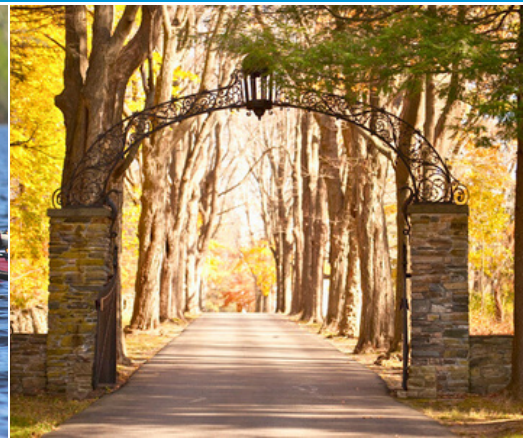
The beautiful campus is centered around the Main Academic Building, which houses classrooms, faculty offices, the Dining Hall, Chapel, and Library. There are a number of athletic playing fields, the Gustavson Track & Field, and the Athletic Complex with gymnasium and dance studios. The residential program includes 6 dormitories (2 male and 4 female) of different sizes, with rooms that house 2, 3, or 4 students and shared bathrooms, with lots of cozy common spaces. House Parents reside in each dormitory, and provide supervision and support.

Activities

All students are encouraged to participate in some of the more than 30 clubs and organizations on campus. There are also many extracurricular opportunities including leadership positions, and LEAP week excursions! Weekends are filled with fun outings, sporting events, shopping, and city trips to Boston and Providence.

Sports
