Academics

Ridley College is an International Baccalaureate (IB) World School, offering both the IB and standard Ontario curriculum. With their student-centered, inquiry-based learning model, they aim to fully support all students in their academic goals. All Ridley graduates will earn the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) and those in grades 11-12 have the option to also enroll in the Diploma Program and earn the IB Diploma or Certificates.

International Baccalaureate (IB) Program

23 IB course options including: English Literature, English Language & Literature, English Literature & Performance, Chinese Literature, French, German, Mandarin, Spanish, Business & Management, Economics, Environmental Systems & Societies, Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Design Technology, Physics, Math Applications & Interpretation, Math Analysis & Approaches, Psychology, History, Film, Music, and Visual Arts.

ESL Program

Ridley College offers two ESL courses for students in Grades 9 and 10. For students in Grades 11 and 12, full English proficiency is required for full integration in the IB curriculum.

100% of students are accepted to a 4 year college or university.

Campus Life

The stunning campus of Ridley College has sweeping grounds and Victorian architecture, and houses modern classrooms and academic space. The newly renovated Iggulden Building features a performance hall, music practice rooms, recording studio, art gallery and more! Athletic facilities include an NHL-grade ice surface, fitness centre, multiple playing fields, tennis courts, squash courts, yoga and spin studios and gymnasium. There are ten boarding houses with mostly double rooms and cozy, modern living spaces.

Activities

Students are very active at Ridley College, with more than 75 clubs and activities offered! All students will participate in one sport and one minor activity for each term, as well as completing 10 community service hours per year. Weekend activities include Saturday morning programming, fun recreational outings as well as school-wide trips, skiing, visits to Toronto and other outdoor adventures!

Teams include: Badminton, Basketball, Cross Country, Field Hockey (girls), Flag Football, Golf, Ice Hockey, Rowing, Rugby, Soccer, Softball (girls), Squash, Swimming, Tennis, Track & Field, Ultimate Frisbee, and Volleyball (girls).
