With a challenging curriculum of more than 126 courses, and a focus on the arts, athletics, leadership, and community service, students are well prepared to be global citizens. Their signature programs include global travel opportunities, and Q-Term, a short, intensive course in May where students can deeply explore a particular subject or passion.

Campus Life

The beautiful campus of Storm King School houses three academic classroom buildings, a library with computer lab, theatre, visual arts centre, gymnasium with fitness center, two athletic fields, four dormitories, and the Orr Commons, overlooking the Hudson River. Students live in single-gender dormitories in either double or triple rooms under the supervision of the faculty and staff members who also reside there.

Activities

Storm King provides a robust array of weekend activities throughout the year, including trips to New York museums and landmarks, outdoor adventure trips, and recreational outings. Students are also required to participate in a daily afternoon activity during each of the three seasons and must choose at least one competitive sport, one athletic team, and a choice from theater or one of several clubs offered each year!

Teams include: Baseball (boys), Basketball, Cross Country, E-Sports, Fencing, Lacrosse, Soccer, Tennis, Ultimate Frisbee, and Volleyball. Co-ed Club teams in: Crew, Fitness, Hiking, Yoga, and Running.
